

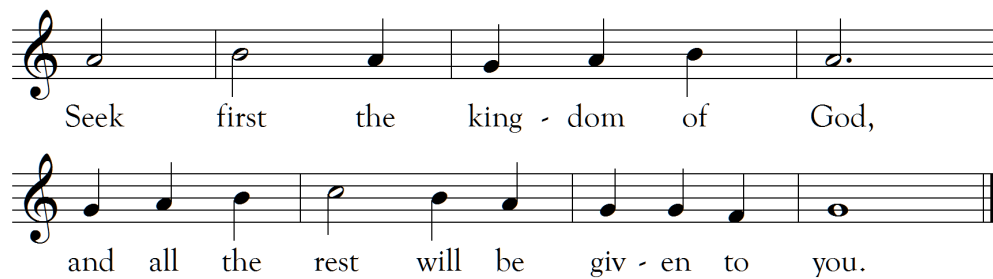
HOLY COMMUNION

We invite all Catholics who are properly disposed (i.e., in the state of grace and having fasted for one hour before communion) to come forward in the usual way to receive Holy Communion.

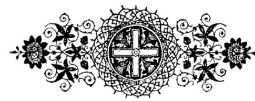

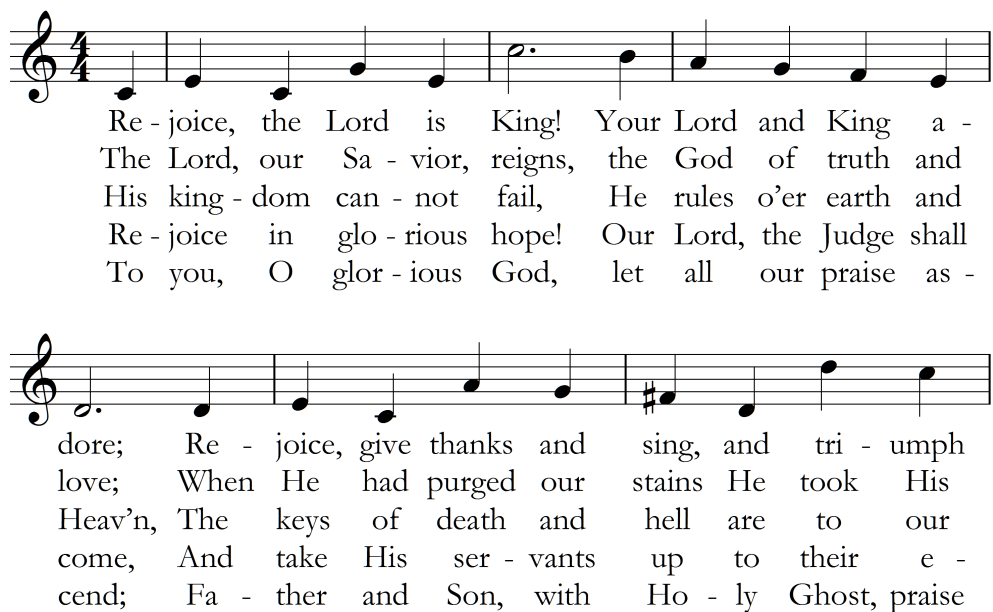

–In late January, the Cathedral signed a contract with the Noack Organ Company for their Opus 164, which will be installed in Summer 2021. Our new pipe organ will be named the Anna Catharine Grace Memorial Pipe Organ in honor of the instrument's major donor. While her generous gift made initiation of the project possible, a large sum must still be raised for the total project cost. That said, after completion, the organ will be one of the finest pipe organs in the United States of America, as well as one which will require relatively little ongoing maintenance after the initial outlay.
