



HOLY COMMUNION

Please join in singing the refrain below after the cantor introduction and between psalm verses.







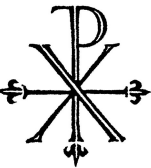
