✠ I do.

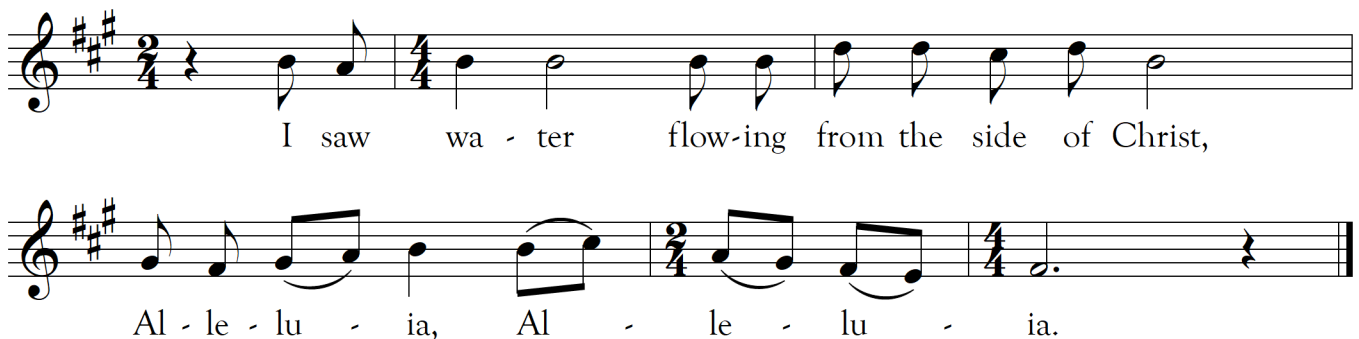
